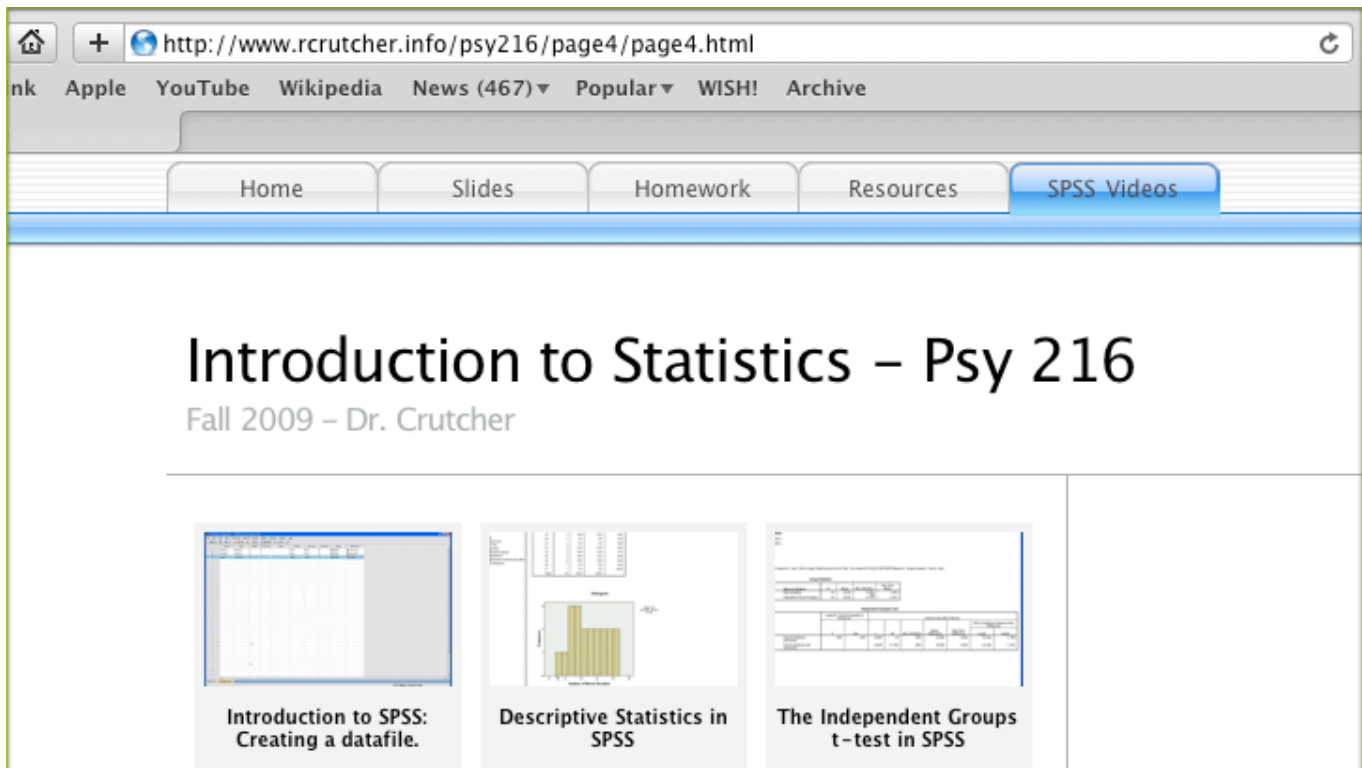

Introduction to Using SPSS

To introduce you to SPSS, I've created some videos of how to use the software. These videos are located in several places to ensure that you can view them at any time. You can find them on the website for the course: <http://www.rcrutcher.info/psy216/index.html>. Click on the **SPSS** tab: Links to the movies are displayed on the page:



If this page loads too slowly, you may have better luck watching the movies from an alternate website location I've created. To get there, click on the **Resources** tab and then click on the SPSS Videos link at the bottom of the page.

When you are in the lab in SJ 003, neither of these may work very well because we often have networking problems in SJ 003. In this case, your best bet is to transfer the videos to your computer. I've put all 3 videos in the Novell Pickup folder for your class. Navigate to this folder and copy the videos one at a time to the desktop of the computer you are working on. You can then double-click on a video file to watch it. You're welcome to transfer the videos to your own Novell Home folder or to a flash drive or other media to take them with you on . However, as I've put them on two different websites, there is probably no need to do this.

You should watch each video while working with SPSS or you may prefer to watch a video and then open SPSS and work from there. You can easily start and stop the videos or watch just the part you need to figure something out.
